Airport Ambassadors

Salt Lake City International Airport has an Airport Ambassadors Volunteer Program to assist passengers with navigating the airport.

Ambassadors help passengers in a variety of ways: They direct passengers to their gates or baggage claim, share information about ground transportation and answer questions about restaurant and shopping options.

With additional phases of The New SLC set to open through 2027, more volunteers are needed to help passengers navigate the growing facility. Those interested in volunteering are asked to commit to at least one, four-hour shift per week and are required to pass a background check. Volunteers will be given an Airport Ambassadors shirt and jacket and receive free parking privileges for their shifts as well as personal travel.
