Car Rental Facilities Entering Final Months of Construction



Walls are rising and concrete is flowing as the car rental facility continues to be the main construction focus of the Salt Lake City Department of Airports' Terminal Redevelopment Program (TRP).


Ten car rental brands will populate the new facility including the Quick-Turn-Around (QTA) building and Rental Car Service Site (RSS) which are anticipated to open in February 2016. Project Scope:

- 19,000 cubic yards of concrete.
- 2,700,000 pounds of reinforcing steel.
- 4,000 stone columns (to form a ground improvement foundation system).
- 125,000 cement masonry unit blocks for wall construction.
- Four 100 ton crawler cranes were used to install the stone columns.
- Two 100 ton crawler cranes are on site for the current concrete construction.
- About 151 workers are on site daily representing a variety of construction trades.
