## Maureen Riley Advances to Second Vice-Chair in ACI-NA Leadership Also Appointed to ACI's World Governing Board

Executive Director of the Salt Lake City Department of Airports, Maureen Riley, has been elected Second Vice-Chair of Airports Council International-North America (ACI-NA) Board of Directors. For the last year, she has served as the Board's Secretary-Treasurer.
