MAUREEN RILEY NAMED DIRECTOR OF THE YEAR BY AIRPORT REVENUE NEWS MAGAZINE

Salt Lake City, UT– Airport Revenue News (ARN) magazine named Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) Executive Director Maureen Riley as 2015 Director of the Year in the large airports category. ARN selected Riley for her leadership in the aviation industry and for her role in overseeing the airport's \$1.8 billion terminal redevelopment program. Riley is featured on the cover of the December/January issue of the publication and will be presented the award at the ARN Conference and Exhibition in March.
