UberX Begins Service at Salt Lake City International Airport

Salt Lake City – Transportation network company UberX is now legally operational and serving ground transportation customers at Salt Lake City International Airport. UberX joins Lyft as the two transportation network companies (TNCs) that have registered with the State of Utah and have been permitted by the Airport as part of a one-year pilot program. Designated pick-up areas for TNCs are located across from baggage claims of both terminals.
