



South Valley Paving Project to Begin Early September

Work will begin on the pavement around South Valley Regional Airport hangars sometime around Sept. 1. Phase 1 of the project will close all pavement areas around the north t-hangar complex to include hangar rows A-D and will last approximately 8 days. Phase 2 will close asphalt areas around hangars E and F and will last 8 days. Tenants will be unable to access their hangars during the project. There will be a limited number of tie-down spaces available for parking during the project. Spaces can be reserved by calling 801-561-0420. Tie-downs are also available at Tooele Valley Airport and can be reserved on a first call basis.
