### **Unveiling Planned for August 27**

Beginning at 9:30 a.m. two former KSL TV reporters—Jennifer Stagg and Andrew Wittenberg—will host a pre-event program to highlight features of The New SLC. Then starting at 10 a.m., Bill Wyatt will kick off the event with a blessing and land recognition by Ute Spiritual Leader Larry Cesspooch, followed by remarks from Lt. Governor Spencer Cox, Mayor Erin Mendenhall, City Council Member Chris Wharton, Delta Air Lines Vice President Scott Santoro and Artist Gordon Huether. Speakers and others in attendance will place noteworthy items in a time capsule that will be placed in the Terminal at future date.

## South Valley Regional Airport FBO Implements New Minimum Fuel Charge for Full-Service Customers

The South Valley Regional Airport FBO implemented a new minimum fuel charge for fullservice customers. A minimum of eight gallons is required for hangar calls. A \$10 service fee will be charged if the minimum fuel purchase requirement is not met.

#### **TVY Sky-Dive Operations**

Sky-Dive Utah resumed a full schedule in July. Sky dive operations run Wednesday through Sunday from sunrise to sunset. Please use caution while in the TVY pattern and while skydivers are in the air. The jump aircraft makes a number of announcements during the jump process to alert aircraft in the area.

#### **TVY Fuel System Update**

The 100LL self-service fuel pedestal remains inoperative. The Airport is working to get the system up and running, but there is no known date of completion. There is a NOTAM in place that indicates the system is out of service. More details will follow in September.

## South Valley Hangar Restrooms Open

The restrooms in the north South Valley hangar are open for business. The restrooms were closed so maintenance crews could repair collapsed drain lines. The building is open to the general public between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. daily. Airport tenants can use the airport code to gain access after hours.
