SLC TAXIWAY K OVERLAY FUNDING PENDING

Taxiway K is scheduled to be re-surfaced sometime during summer 2019. The airport is currently waiting for project funding from the FAA. Work will commence on the overlay once the project is funded.

The current construction plan has the project divided into six phases. The overlay is expected to take approximately 10 days to complete. Edge lights on taxiway K will also be upgraded to LED lights during the project.

Aircraft taxi route changes will take place during different phases of the project. Aircraft operators should check NOTAMS throughout the project and plan accordingly. Pilots should plan extra time for added taxi distances and routes. Dates will be provided as they become available.



ST. GEORGE AIRPORT CLOSURE

Runway 1/19 at St. George Municipal Airport (SGU) is scheduled for major reconstruction this summer. The runway will be closed between May 29 and September 26. The airport will be closed to all fixed wing aircraft during this time.

SLC International Spring Runway Closures

TVY RAMP CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN SOON

Black Forrest Paving was the winning bidder for the Tooele Valley Airport (TVA) South Ramp Restoration project. The project should begin in late April and is expected take between 10 and 14 days to complete. Tenants will be able to access the restrooms and south hangars through a manual gate in the area. Taxiway A will have reduced wingtip clearances and possible back taxing for two days during the project.
