Atlantic Aviation Opens New Facility at SLC International

Atlantic Aviation opened its new FBO facility at the Salt Lake City International Airport on March 1. The facility consists of two, 30,000 square foot hangars and a 12,500 square foot passenger terminal. A Grand Opening event is planned for Wednesday, April 18 from 2 to 5 p.m.

Construction continues on the northwest corner of the Atlantic Aviation facility ramp where a \$1.4 million concrete heavy aircraft parking pad is underway.

The hangars and passenger terminal are a large part of the \$30 million dollars Atlantic has invested at Salt Lake International the past two years.
