The Annual Salt Lake City Department of Airports General Aviation BBQ will be held on Saturday, Sept. 16 from 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. at South Valley Regional Airport. The event will be in Hangar 3, north of the FBO building.

Allstate Fire will be on location between noon and 3 p.m. to service tenant fire extinguishers for a fee. Airport rules and regulations require all tenants to have fire extinguishers in their hangars that are inspected annually. The last hangar inspection revealed there were several tenants currently out of compliance. This service will give tenants a chance to come into compliance before fall inspections beginning in late September.
