Airport Hangar Master Key Use

The Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) maintains a master key to open all general aviation hangars. The general aviation manager, airport properties leasing specialist and South Valley Regional Airport maintenance personnel all have a copy of the master key. The key is used to unlock a hangar for the following reasons:

- · Address a maintenance problem
- Prevent property damage or for safety purposes
- Verify whether or not an overdue aircraft is in the hangar
- Assist a registered tenant to unlock their keys in the hangar

Airport staff cannot open hangars for anyone that is not listed on the hangar lease. Requests after hours to unlock a hangar will be determined on a case-by-case basis. SLCDA cannot accept the liability of allowing people access to a hangar that they do not lease. Contact General Aviation Manager Dave Teggins at 801-556-4082 with questions.
