General Aviation Airport Snow Removal

Winter weather is here! Following are a few reminders about how General Aviation areas will be cleared when the snow flies:

- SLC crews will plow east side taxiways and taxilanes after the commercial runways, taxiways and aprons are cleared.
- Fixed Base Operators are required to clear their own aprons to the edge of their lease lines prior to airport crews plowing taxiways.
- Taxiway A and the runway at South Valley Regional Airport will typically be cleared and deiced by 9 a.m. Crews will work throughout the day to keep taxilanes and common ramps usable.
- Tooele Valley Airport will not be cleared until crews complete snow removal operations at SLC.
- Snow crews will clear snow from General Aviation hangar fronts within four feet of entrances. Tenants are responsible for clearing remaining snow.
