### **Airport Launches New Website, Including Interactive Map and Sustainability Tracking Tool**

Salt Lake City – The Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) has launched a new website. The updated [www.slcairport.com](http://www.slcairport.com) offers a more user-friendly and visually appealing interface and is responsive to all mobile devices.

Key features include an [interactive terminal map](#), which allows passengers to easily view gates, restrooms, shops, restaurants and airport amenities. An improved [Flight Search](#) function is also available as well as a new [Parking and Transportation](#) page that provides clear and comprehensive information for all passenger transportation options.

As part of the redesigned website, SLC now offers a new [Sustainability Dashboard](#) tool that tracks metrics in eight areas of airport operations, including energy use, water conservation and waste reduction. The public is encouraged to view areas of airport sustainability performance and make suggestions.

Data used in the Dashboard, including goals for improvements, are based on the airport's [2015 Sustainability Management Plan](#), funded by a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration. The SLC Sustainability Dashboard will continue to monitor the sustainability performance of the airport as work continues on more efficient facilities with the Terminal Redevelopment Program.
