SLC International Airport to Host Art Open House

Artist Gordon Huether to Preview "Swallows in Flight" Art Installation

What: The Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) is hosting an Art Open

House to highlight the latest large-scale art installation titled "Swallows in Flight." The installation hangs from the ceiling on Concourse B-west and is comprised of 2,051 swallow bird laser-cut acrylic shapes with dichroic film applied. Each swallow weighs 4 oz. with the complete installation weighing

approx. 513 lbs.

In addition, the SLC DA offices will be open to the public to view the nearly 250 pieces of art on display that were once housed in the previous airport. Works by artists such as David Adams, Marianne Cone, Toni Doilney, Susan Gallacher, Anton Rasmussen, Douglas Snow, Trevor Southey and LeConte Stewart

will be on display.
