SLC International Airport Seeks Public Input on Draft Environmental Assessment *Public Meeting Planned for August 27*

- What:** The Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA), in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration, is seeking public comments on a draft Environmental Assessment to evaluate Southern Infrastructure Improvements, which include the proposed relocation of the surplus canal along with other enhancements on the south end of the airfield. The proposed improvements aim to accommodate future airport growth and include conceptual designs, environmental impacts and mitigation measures. Comments will be accepted at an Open House as well as online.
