## Salt Lake City Department of Airports to Provide a Sneak Peek of The World Map's New Home

What:	The World Map graced the floor of Terminal 1 in the former airport for 60 years. It was created from a design by Dallas stoneworker Julius Bartoli based on drawings by Ashton, Evans & Brazier. The World Map was a source of delight and wonder for thousands of people from all over the world for many years. Initially, the engineers did not think it was possible to remove the World Map without damaging the pieces, but after further research found it would be possible. The World Map was removed from Terminal 1 and has been in storage until recently when it was reinstalled in Concourse B Plaza. The World Map will be open to the public when Phase 3 opens on October 22, 2024. The media event will take place on the construction site, so be sure to wear long
