TOUCH N' GO CONVENIENCE STORE FACT SHEET

Background: The Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) is opening an 8,400 sq. ft. Touch n' Go Convenience Store to better serve the traveling public. This \$4 million facility was built by Kellerstrass Oil Company, along with HB Boys and Big D Construction. Kellerstrass operates the facility and HB Boys is the third-party manager that is responsible for daily operations. Construction began on the facility in June 2017.

Salt Lake-based **Kellerstrass Oil** has been an independent petroleum marketer since 1948 and serves customers in Utah, Wyoming, Idaho, Nevada and Colorado. The company offers expert service, quality refined products, lubricants, anti-freeze and solvents.

HB Boys, L.C. is a management company based in Salt Lake City and has been in business for more than 30 years. HB Boys currently operates 62 Burger King® restaurants, 11 gas stations/convenience stores, six Costa Vida® restaurants, six Beans and Brews® Coffeehouses, and three Subway® restaurant throughout Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Utah and Wyoming.

Tenants:

-Burger King (2,500 sq. ft.)-Will offer a breakfast and lunch menu throughout the day from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.

-Costa Vida (2,500 sq. ft.)-Costa Vida is a fast-casual restaurant inspired by the fresh tasting foods and vibrant lifestyle from the coast of Mexico. Headquartered in Salt Lake City, Costa Vida opened its first restaurant in 2003 and is one of the fastest growing restaurant franchises in North America with locations throughout the U.S. and Canada. Airport location open 11 a.m. to 10 p.m.

-Beans and Brews Coffee House (400 sq. ft.)-Beans and Brews opened for business in 1993 in Salt Lake City and has worked to refine the process of high-altitude roasting and built a reputation for uniquely smooth coffee. Beans and Brews operates nearly 50 locations across Utah, Nevada and Idaho. Airport location open 5 a.m. to 10 p.m.

-Chevron Fueling Station and Convenience Store (2,600 sq. ft.)-Chevron-brand unleaded, mid-grade, premium and diesel. One electric charging station. Open 24/7.

Features:

-Flight information display monitors located inside the store for customers to keep an eye on flight arrival times. A drive-through window for quick orders and pick-up.

-The building's exterior design is consistent with color schemes similar to The New SLC Redevelopment Program.
