Cyndy Miller called the meeting, held via Web-Ex to order at 8:08 a.m.

AGENDA

A. Minutes

A motion was made by Larry Pinnock and seconded by J.T. Martin to approve the minutes of February 19, 2020 as presented. All votes were affirmative; motion passed.

B. Director's Report

Bill Wyatt, Executive Director, updated the Airport Advisory Board regarding current events.

Mr. Wyatt indicated the budget presented today is going to change significantly over the next twelve months.

Today, the airport will welcome 1,900 passengers through security. This is the lowest number in the history of the airport. Normally, passenger volume is around 20,000. Airlines have reduced their flights at SLCIA 75 – 90%. Even those flights have low seat load factors.

September 11, 2001 was a very different experience. There was limited air travel, but with increased security measures in places, those numbers slowly grew. That is not happening today.

While new positions are needed for the new airport, and with some in the current budget, they won't be filled. Capital Improvement Projects have been eliminated that are not included in the ARP or doesn't have federal funding. Operation and Maintenance costs are being kept as low as possible.

C. Airport Redevelopment Program (ARP) Update – Mike Williams, ARP Director, SLCDA

Mike Williams, Airport Redevelopment Program (ARP) Director, presented an update on the ARP (presentation on file). Main points included were:

Larry Pinnock asked if there were any surprises from the earthquake with stabilization, pilings, and overall construction. Mr. Williams reported there were some ceiling grids and tiles damaged along with some cracked drywall, but overall everything performed well. Structural engineers happened to be onsite at the time of the earthquake and were able to assess the parking garage.

J.T. Martin inquired as to what level of earthquake is the structure built to. Mr. Williams said the building was built to withstand a major seismic event which is about a 7.4 magnitude earthquake. The only other facility built to a higher standard would be a critical care facility.

Dirk Burton asked about available recliners for rent to passengers with long layovers. Mr. Williams indicated that no, there are not recliners available. There is a lot of comfortable seating in the plaza. There are also some massage concessions. Mr. Wyatt added information regarding the concerns with individuals sleeping in the airport pre-security. Mayor Mendenhall added

language to her emergency proclamation to cover restrictions on airport access. SLCIA is hub airport and connection times are usually pretty quick, unlike airports like Singapore that may have hours in-between flights. The Skyclub is also available for members.

J.T. Martin asked how many massage concessionaires will there be at the new airport? Mr. Wyatt responded that there will be two; one in the north concourse and one in the south.

D. Budget Presentation – Brian Butler, Chief Financial Officer

Brian Butler, Chief Financial Officer, presented the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget (presentation on file.) Main points included were:

Cyndy Miller acknowledged several comments made by the public in regard to Non-Domiciled Employee Parking. Through discussion, it was determined this topic would be discussed at the next board meeting.

Cyndy Miller left the meeting at 9:30 am.

E. Call for Motion to Approve the Budget – Cyndy Miller

Steve Price, in Cyndy Miller's absence called for a motion for a vote for approval of FY2021 Budget. Upon a motion by Shawn Milne and seconded by Theresa Foxley, the board approved the FY2021 Budget and supports its presentation to the Mayor and City Council for acceptance. All votes were affirmative.

Steve Price adjourned the meeting at 9:42 a.m.

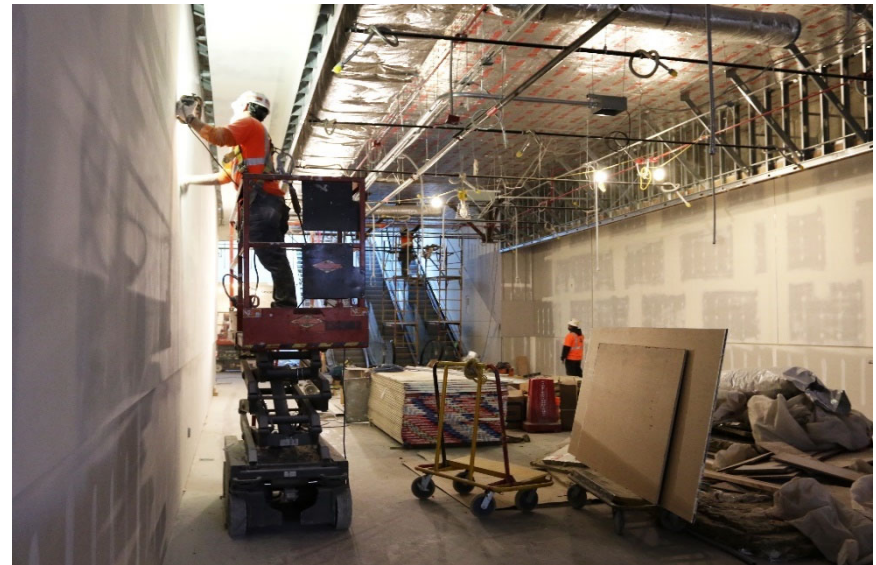

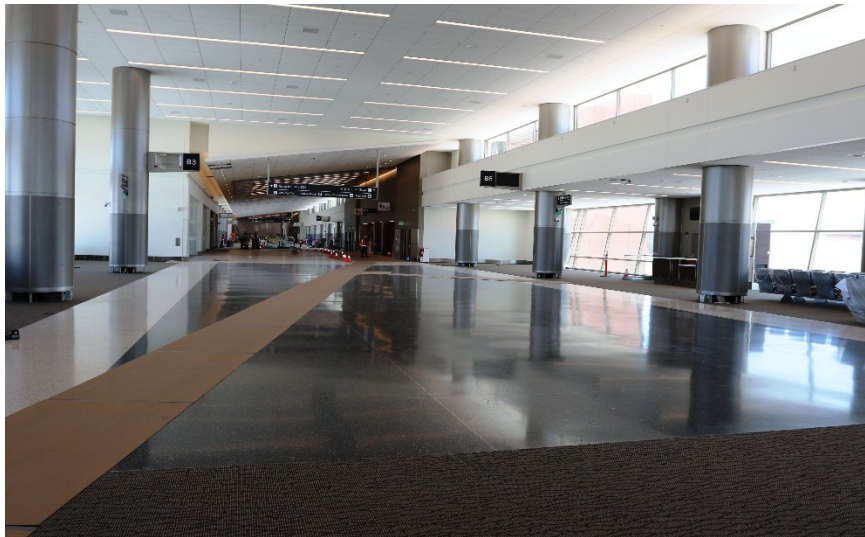

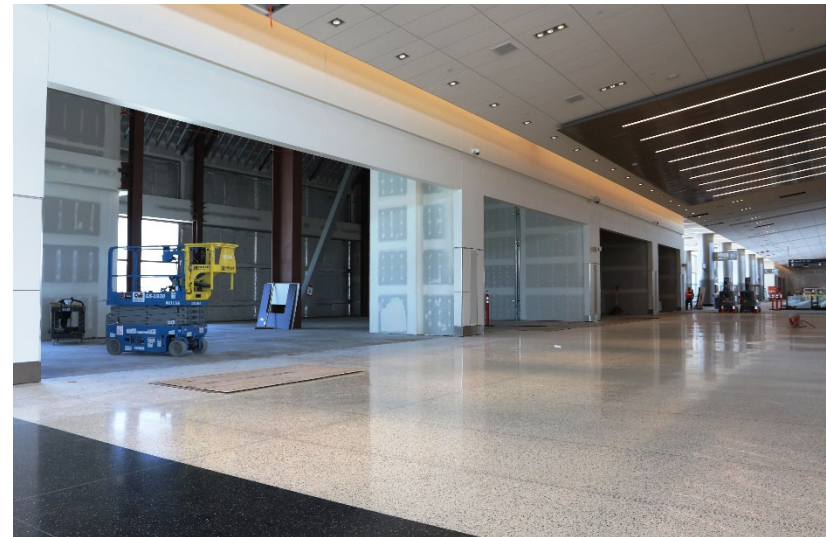

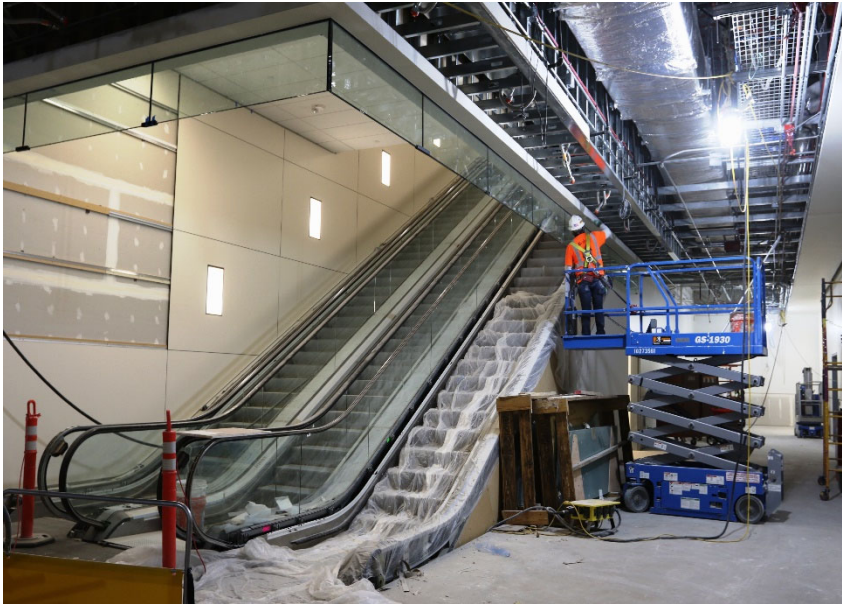

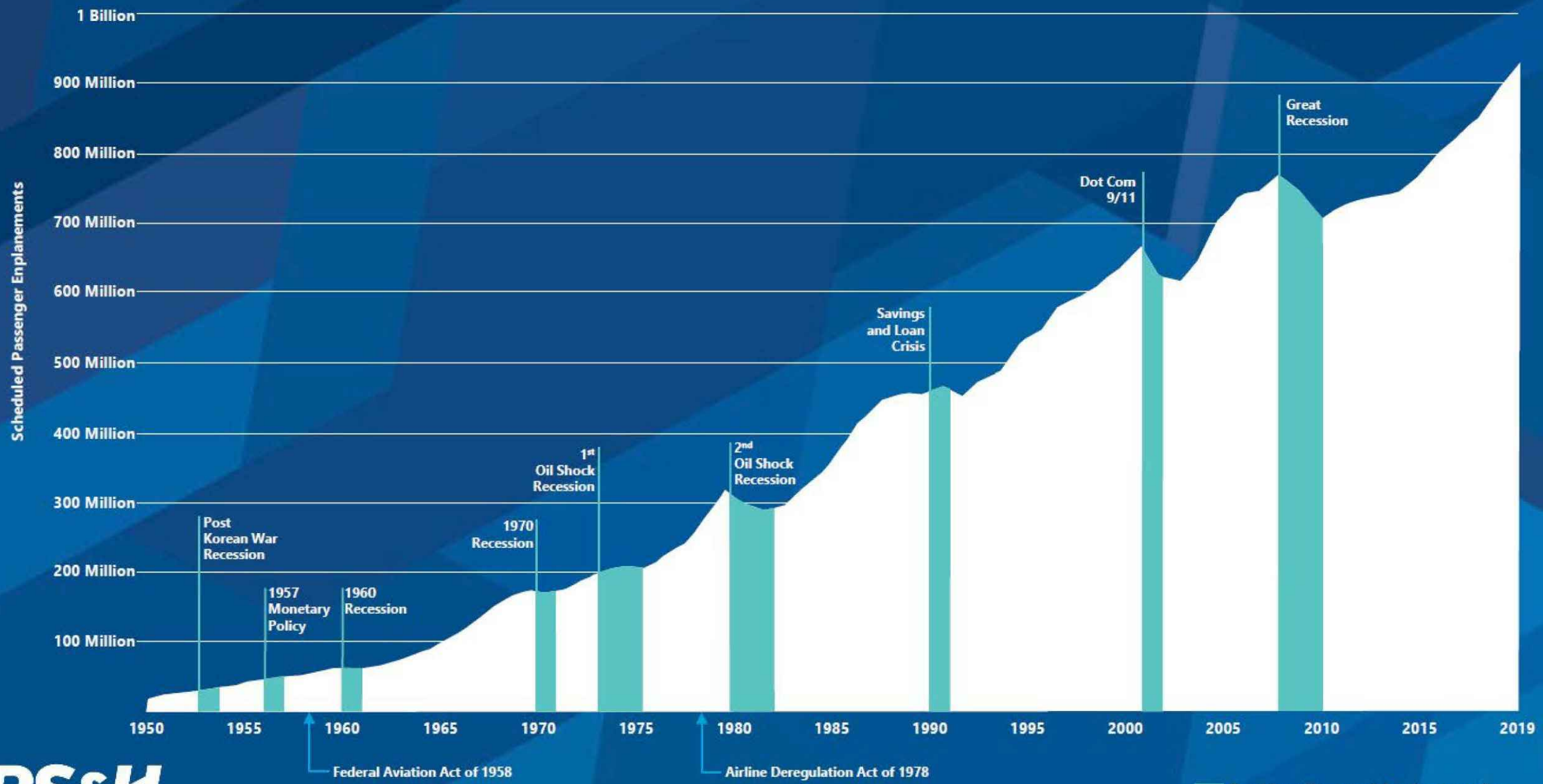

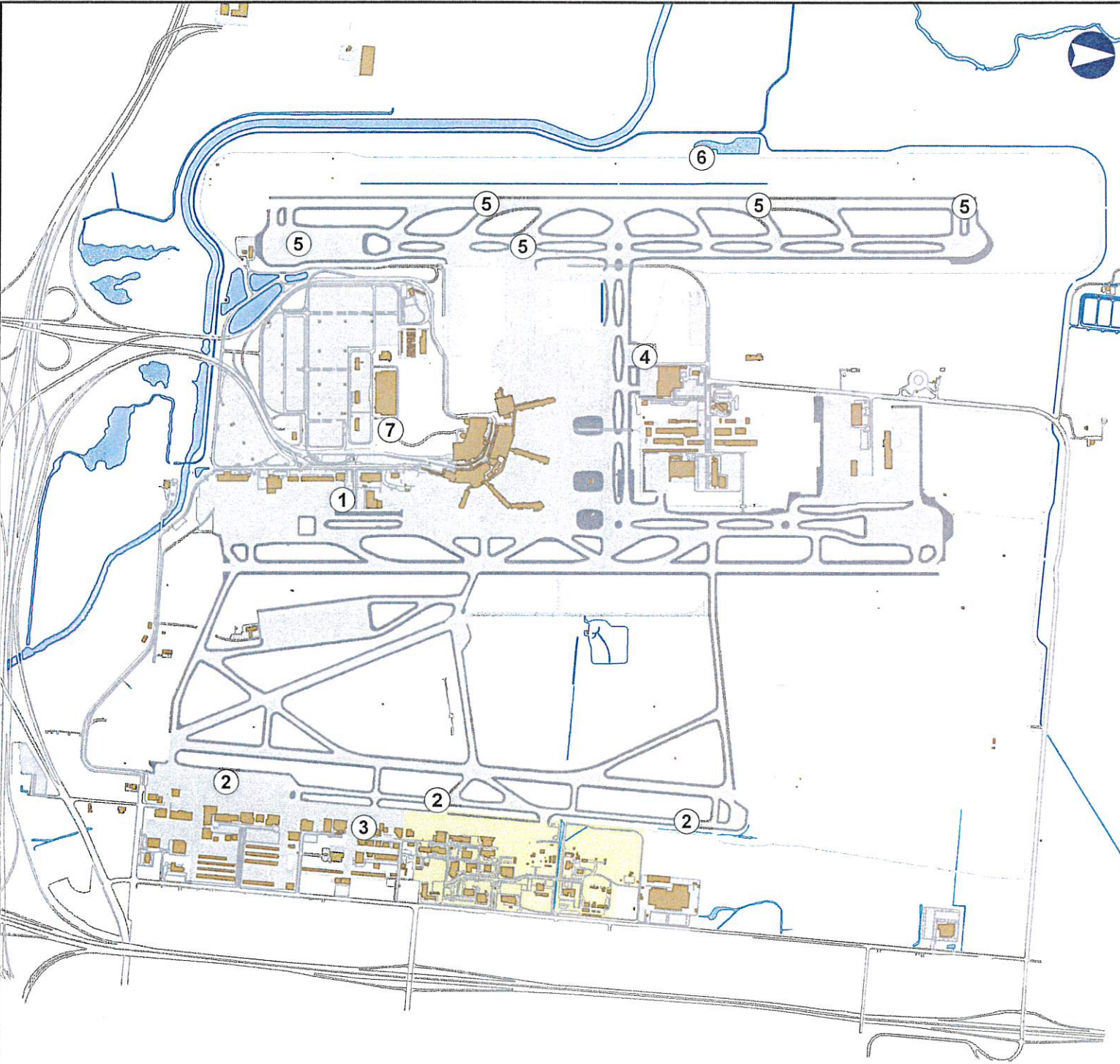

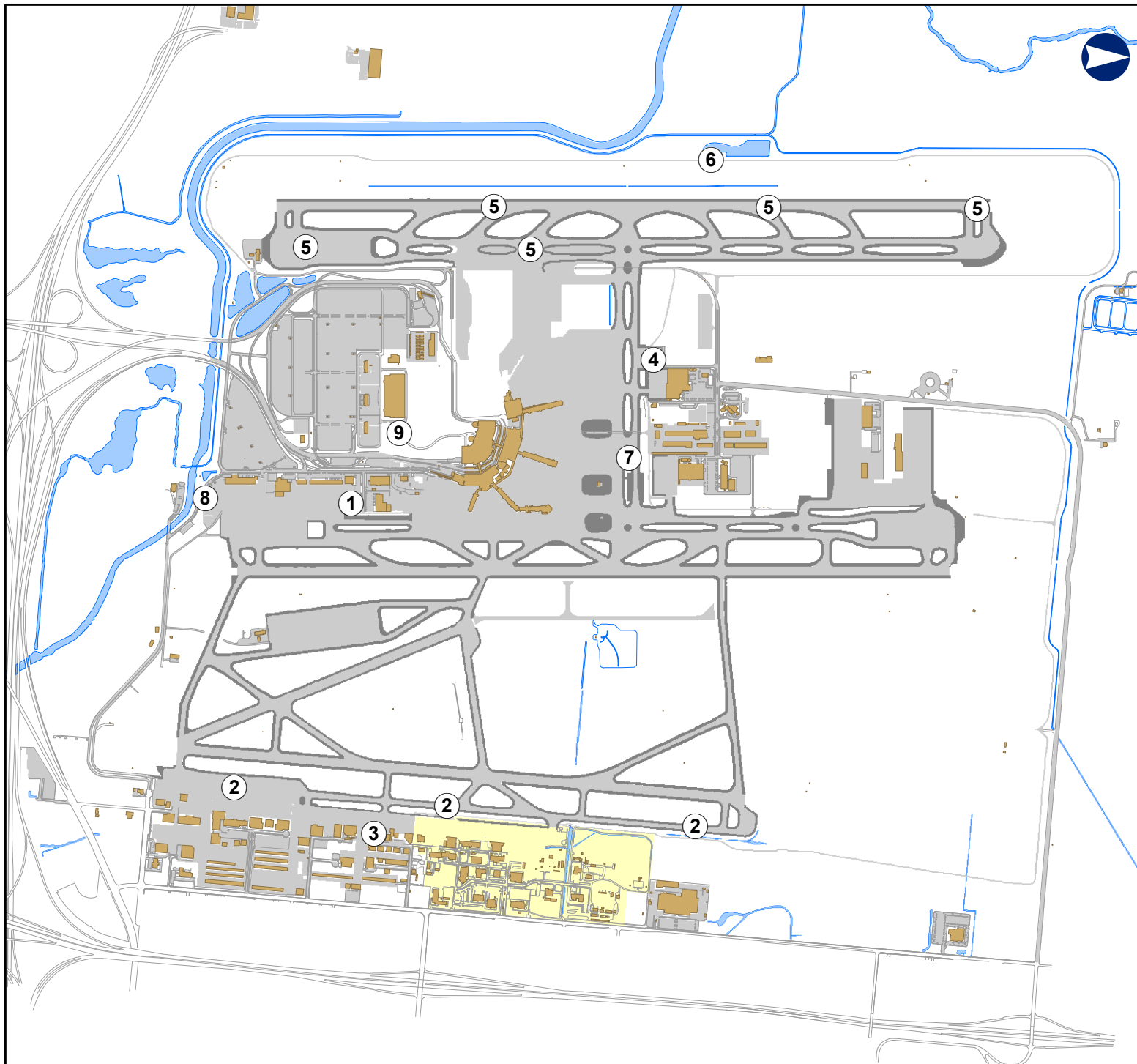

- (8) **Relocate Gate 10 & 11** - This project will relocate Gate 10 & 11 guard booth and canopy. The bid opening for this project was held on April 2, 2020. The only bidder for this project was Staker Parson Companies. Contract documents are currently being executed.

CONSTRUCTION

- (1) **Central Screening Warehouse** - The Contractor is finishing up punch list items for the Central Screening Warehouse. Construction has begun for the building tenant, Bradford Logistics, with an anticipated completion date of August 15, 2020.
- (2) **Taxiway K Pavement Rehabilitation** - Construction resumed on May 4, 2020 for Phase two of this project, between spot 26 and 30 and the work is nearing completion. The Contractor will progress working to the north.
- (3) **Fire Station 11 Roof Replacement and Solar Panel Installation** - Substantial completion for this project was issued to the Contractor on April 20, 2020. All punch list items have been completed.
- (4) **Fire Station 12 Roof Replacement and Solar Panel Installation** - Substantial completion for this project was issued to the Contractor on April 20, 2020. All punch list items have been completed.
- (5) **Airfield Lighting Wiring Phase 4** - The Contractor, Royal Electric Company started work on May 4, 2020. The majority of the work on this project will be completed during a night shift schedule.
- (6) **Pump House No. 1 Reconstruction** - A notice to proceed was issued to the Contractor on February 5, 2019. Submittals are currently being reviewed by the design team and SLCDA. The temporary construction fence is being installed and the Contractor is mobilizing to start construction.
- (7) **Taxiway E Reconstruction** - The Contractor is currently working on the first phase of this project excavating and rebuilding base course in preparation for the electrical work and paving.
- (9) **Parking Lot E (South)** - Excavation and disposal of existing material for this project will be completed by May 15, 2020. The Contractor has completed the light pole foundation installation. The underground electrical and communication work is approximately 75% completed. Storm drain pipe installation is currently taking place with the new catch basin work to follow.
