New Concessions Open and More to Come!

New shops and restaurants are coming online each month at Salt Lake City International Airport with more expected in the coming months. The past month, the Deseret News and Visit Salt Lake have opened in Concourse A. Currently, 64% of concessions are operational and 14% are under construction. By end of summer, 86% will be operational and 14% deferred to a later date.



Here's a preview of what will be coming this spring: Fillings & Emulsions, Garbanzo, MAC, Panda Express, Roosters, Smashburger, Starbucks and UNO. In the summer and fall look for: Briggs & Riley, Coach, FRYE, Panera Bread, Pizzeria Limone and Pick Up Stix.


Stone Columns Installation Now Underway

Stone column installation has begun on the second phase of The New SLC Redevelopment program. Phase II includes the build-out of Concourse A to the east. Delta Tower Demolished

The 84-foot tall Delta Tower that was built in 1989 to direct aircraft to the gate came down on Monday, February 15. The demolition marks a major milestone in Phase II of The New SLC. <u>Click here</u> to see footage of the demolition.

Central Tunnel Construction Moves Forward

As part of The New SLC Airport Phase 2, a permanent tunnel is being constructed between concourses A and B, which will ease walking times. Construction workers are installing H-Piles at an average of 17 per day to create a solid foundation.
