

Say Hello to The New SLC Phase 3 Concessions



Phase 3 concessions were announced in June in the Concourse B Plaza, which is currently under construction.

On June 20, the Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) announced 12 additional restaurants and retail shops planned for The New SLC – Phase 3, which is scheduled to open in fall 2024.

The concession operators selected for the 19,260 sq. ft. of space are: Bambuza Hospitality Group, HMSHost, Marshall Retail Group, When selecting the concessions for Phase 3, SLCDA's commercial management team looked for a mix of local, regional and national brands, while taking pricing, hours of operation and service standards into consideration.

Requirements for the six food and beverage locations included three fullservice restaurants with alcohol Paradies Lagardère, SLC Airport Concessions Group and SSP America, which represent the following brands and concepts:

Food and Beverage: Bambuza Vietnam Kitchen; Freddy's Frozen Custard and Steakburgers; Maggiano's Little Italy; Sunday's Best; The Coffee Bean and Tea Leaf; and Thirst.

Retail, News and Gift: Cotopaxi; iStore Express; Relay; Travel Right; The Canyon; and Weller Book Works.

Sunday's Best, Thirst, Weller Book Works, Cotopaxi and The Canyon are all local brands.


service, a local/national fast-food or gourmet/specialty burger brand, a quick-serve restaurant and a dedicated full-service coffee concept.

For all of the concepts, street pricing is a requirement. Many of the businesses selected for Phase 3 are ACDBE-certified (Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise).

Phase 3 encompasses a nine-gate extension of Concourse B to the east. The first five gates will open in fall 2024, followed by four gates in fall 2025.

Four New Gates Opening on Concourse A-east



On August 22, four additional Delta gates will open on Concourse A-east. While the gate-hold area has been open to the public since May, work on the boarding bridges and airfield still needed to be completed.

On October 31, the final 13 gates on Concourse A-east will open for a total of 22 gates and 19 concessions.



The New SLC Construction Update


The New SLC Phase 3 is well underway and on track to open in fall 2024. Phase 3 includes a mini-Plaza in Concourse B and a Central Tunnel – to connect concourses A and B. 
Artist Gordon Huether visited the Central Tunnel to see the progress of The River Tunnel art installation
