Avelo is the only airline offering nonstop service between SLC and Charles M. Schulz Sonoma County Airport (STS). Sonoma County is SLC's 100th nonstop destination. The route is offered twiceweekly on Thursdays and Sundays aboard a Boeing Next-Generation 737 aircraft.

Delta Announces Nonstop Service from SLC to Seoul

Delta is boosting its global footprint with the launch of its first-ever nonstop service from SLC to Seoul-Incheon International Airports (ICN) on June 12, 2025, aboard an Airbus A350-900 aircraft. This route—the only direct flight linking Salt Lake City to Asia—will provide seamless connections to key destinations across Asia for travelers throughout the Mountain West and Southwest U.S. regions. Through ICN, travelers can seamlessly connect to 80 plus destinations in Asia through Korean Air-Delta's joint venture partner.

Phase 4 Concessions Announced

The new airport is continually recognized as having one of the best concession programs in the country with many of the brands and concepts selected being Utah-based.

Passenger Numbers for Summer 2024

While official numbers aren't in, SLC International expects that the summer 2024 season will have been the busiest on record. Demand continues to be robust, driven by strong leisure growth in addition to a nearly recovered business travel market. Almost every airline at SLC added seat capacity at the airport this summer to new and existing markets, resulting in 6% more seats compared to last summer.

In recent quarterly earnings, however, it was widely reported by U.S. airlines that while demand was at record levels, revenue per passenger was down. This is pushing airlines to tighten up capacity growth beginning this fall and into the winter to boost revenues. Subsequently, seat growth at SLC during the last quarter is anticipated to slow to approximately 3-4% compared to Q4 2023. On October 24, SLC will welcome its 14th carrier and 100th destination when Avelo Airlines launches new weekly service to Santa Rosa/Sonoma, California.
