Hangar Inspections Scheduled for South Valley Regional and SLC International

- Valid inspection stickers for fire extinguishers
- Proper storage of hazardous material
- Proper sized electrical cords
- Appropriate aircraft in hangar

May 20-23 Runway 16L-34R

June 3-6 Runway 17-35

Runways will close at 11 p.m. the day of the closure and will reopen at 7 a.m. on the last closure date listed. Please check NOTAMS prior to coming out to the airport to assure there have not been any changes to this schedule.
