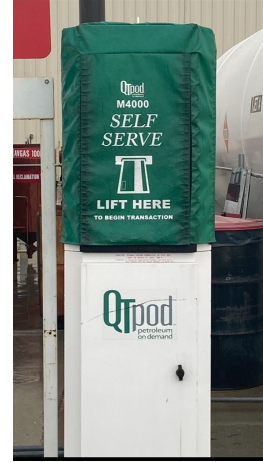


Self Fueling at SLCDAs Airports

Self fueling one's aircraft is authorized at Salt Lake City International Airport, South Valley Regional Airport and Tooele Valley Airport

only with a self-fuel permit. To qualify for a permit, individual pilots must submit a written application and demonstrate refueling knowledge and skills to the Fire Marshall and the General Aviation Manager.

Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) operations personnel or police officers may require pilots who are self fueling their aircraft to produce their SLCDA Self-Fueling Permit. Self fueling without a permit is not authorized and citations may be issued.
