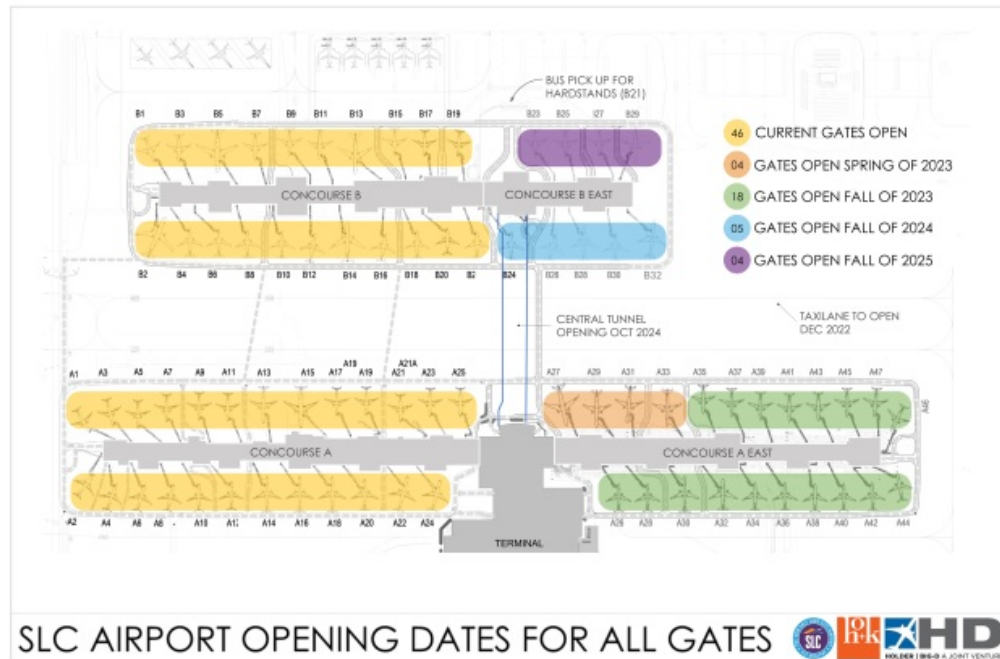
## Use Caution When Flying in Tooele Valley

Pilots are encouraged to be extra cautious when flying in the Tooele Valley area. There is a 250-foot crane located 4.6 nautical miles south southeast of the Tooele Valley Airport. A NOTAM is in place through Dec. 31, but the duration is expected to go well into the new year. The crane is flagged during the day and is lighted at night.

## The New SLC Phase 2 Construction Updates

- A Topping Out Ceremony was held Oct. 13 to place one of the final steel beams on Concourse A-east. The first four gates of the build out are scheduled to open in May 2023.
- SLC International celebrated the one-year anniversary of The New SLC by announcing the project had received LEED Gold Certification from the U.S. Green Building Council.
- After 20 months of construction, the TRAX platform at SLC opened on Oct. 22. UTA is offering free rides to passengers with a boarding pass through Jan. 31, 2022.
