The South Valley Regional Airport FBO will be closed on Christmas Day, Dec. 25, and New Year's Day, Jan. 1. Self-service fuel will be available to customers on both days.

Santa Flight Delivers Supplies to Parowan Elementary







On Dec. 8, approximately 25 aircraft departed airports around the Wasatch Front with donated goods as a part of Angel Flight West's annual Santa Flight. Each year, the event delivers supplies and clothing to underprivileged schools in Utah. This year, the program selected Parowan Elementary in Southern Utah as its recipient. South Valley Regional Airport served as the distribution point for receiving and sorting supplies for the event.

Winter Runway Condition Assessments

The Salt Lake City Department of Airports reports winter runway conditions using the FAA-approved Runway Condition Assessment Matrix (RCAM). These notifications are distributed through the national NOTAM system. RCAM rates runway braking conditions on a scale of zero to six with perfect conditions earning a rating of six and conditions with nil braking warranting a rating of zero. NOTAMs show the condition score for the runway in three parts: touchdown, midpoint and roll out. South Valley Regional and Tooele Valley airports will close when RCAM ratings fall below a three. **Learn more about RCAM**.
