SLC International Sets Passenger and Business Jet Records During Presidents' Day Weekend

Ski travel and the NBA All-Star Game helped Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) set commercial passenger and business jet records during Presidents' Day weekend.

The general aviation side of the airfield saw massive traffic movements throughout the weekend. Activity peaked on Feb. 19 with 65 business jets departing within a 75-minute window, immediately following the

conclusion of the All-Star Game. FBO partners Atlantic Aviation and Signature Aviation worked together to provide worldclass service to the passengers and pilots visiting SLC.

SLC also broke its single-day commercial passenger record over the holiday weekend, with more than 35,000 passengers being screened at its security checkpoints on Feb. 20.

Spring hangar inspections are scheduled for the week of March 21 at South Valley Regional Airport and Salt Lake City International Airport. The purpose of these inspections is to ensure tenants are complying with safety and lease standards. Key inspection points include:

- Valid inspection stickers on all fire extinguishers
- Proper storage of hazardous materials
- Appropriate electrical cord usage
- Airworthy aircraft in hangars
