KSLC AND KU42 T-HANGAR LOCK AND RE-KEY

The padlocks on the Salt Lake International Airport and South Valley Regional Airport T-hangars will be re-keyed beginning the middle of August. Re-Keying will start at Salt Lake International and move to South Valley Regional once work is completed at Salt Lake International. Hangar tenants will be issued new keys after the work is completed. Please send an email to Phil.Bevan@slcgov.com with your hangar number, email address and phone number. This will be used to send accurate and updated information when keys are ready for dispersal.

KSLC RWY 17/35 OVERLAY POSTPONED

The runway 17/35 overlay project has been delayed due to funding issues. The project is estimated to start on August 5, but further delays are possible. The project will follow the following construction plan once begun.

Phase I 20 Calendar DaysRunway 17/35 and taxiways R and K9 will close for 20 calendar days.

Phase II 10 Calendar Days

Taxiway K1, runway 14/32, and runway 17/35 will close for 10 calendar days. This is the only phase of the project that runway 14/32 will not be available.

Phase III 40 Calendar Days

Runway 17/35 and taxiway P will be closed for 40 calendar days.

Phase IV 30 Calendar Days

Runway 17/35 and associated taxiways will be available for daylight operations only. At night, crews will be upgrading lighting, surface painting and grooving the runway.

Please carefully check NOTAMS prior to operating from Salt Lake International for details concerning this construction project.

Atlantic Aviation is temporarily moving its passenger terminal to make way for new hangars and for passenger terminal development. The new terminal will be located at 470 North 2360 West. The building housed Hudson General many years ago. Atlantic Aviation reports they are making a significant investment to create a temporary customer service area while the new facilities are being constructed.
