

Apron Upgrade Progressing at SVR

The apron upgrade at South Valley Regional Airport (SVR) is now underway. The project is part of a broader effort to modernize infrastructure and enhance the experience at SVR. The upgrade will improve pavement quality and clean surface markings, which will boost safety with improved traction, reduce foreign object (FOD) debris as well as extend the pavement's lifespan.

New in-pavement centerlines are now in place, which clearly mark aircraft parking positions such as designated reserved parking spots and general tie-down locations. This makes ramp navigation easier for pilots both based at SVR as well as transient flyers. Even though work is ongoing, pilots and visitors have noticed a cleaner, more durable and better-organized ramp. The project will be completed by late summer.
