## **Pavement Preservation and Tie-Down Project Planned**

South Valley Regional Airport (KSVR) is preparing for a new infrastructure improvement project focused on preserving airport pavement and improving aircraft tiedown areas. This project is part of ongoing efforts to maintain a safe and efficient airport for the community.

The pavement preservation work will include sealing, patching and repainting various paved surfaces around the airport apron. These improvements are essential for extending the life of existing pavement and ensuring a safer environment for aircraft operations.

In addition to the pavement improvements, designated tie-down areas will be upgraded to improve usability and overall experience. These enhancements will support current needs and provide added convenience for those using the airport.

Construction is expected to begin at the end of May and will proceed in phases to minimize disruptions to airport operations. Notices to Air Mission (NOTAMs) will be issued in advance of any temporary closures or changes in access. The airport team will work closely with tenants and users throughout the process to ensure a smooth transition.

All pilots and tenants are encouraged to stay informed by checking airport updates and preparing for brief interruptions in tie-down availability or access to select taxiways. The airport team will continue to provide updates as the project progresses.
