## SLC International General Aviation Paving Project Begins August 28

Granite Construction was awarded the contract for the general aviation area asphalt paving project. The same contractor is performing the runway 14/32 overlay. Work is expected to begin on August 28. The final phasing is still in process and firm dates for the different phases are not available yet. Be aware that hangars could be blocked between 10- to 14-days during the paving project.

The paving project is the last component of the runway 16/34 overlay and taxiway re-design project. The \$3 million project involved laying 20,000 tons of asphalt material, use of 4,500 cubic yards.
