Every year, millions of Americans miss an important medical appointment simply because they don't have transportation. For some, the care they need may only be a few miles away, but without viable transportation options, they may have no way of getting there. For others, the ones who need to travel great distances, it's even more complicated.

Angel Flight West (AFW) bridges the gap between home, transportation and health care, providing hope for a better future to patients and their families.

This year, through a network of volunteer pilots and partnerships with commercial airlines, AFW will provide approximately 5,000 free flights in Utah, and to 12 other western states for medical services and treatment.

AFW will also arrange transportation for other needs, including for individuals and families escaping domestic violence, injured military personnel taking part in therapeutic programs, and specialized youth health camps, such as burn survivors or kids with cancer.

Every December, AFW's Utah pilots congregate at South Valley Regional and take to the skies for Santa Flights, delivering clothing, supplies and toys to children at a Title 1 schools.
