GENERAL AVIATION AIRPORT SNOW REMOVAL

Winter weather will soon be upon us! Here are a few reminders about snow removal in the General Aviation areas:

- SLC crews will plow eastside taxiways and taxi lanes after commercial runways, taxiways and aprons are cleared.
- Fixed Base Operators are required to clear their own aprons to the edge of their lease lines prior to airport crews plowing taxiways
- Taxiway A and the runway at South Valey Regional Airport (U42) will normally be cleared and de-iced by 9:00 a.m. after a snow event. Snow crews will work throughout the day to keep the taxi lanes and common ramps usable.
- Tooele Valley Airport (TVY) will not be cleared until SLC crews have completed snow removal operations at Salt Lake City International Airport.
- Snow crews will normally clear snow from GA hangar fronts to within four feet of hangar entrances. Tenants are responsible for clearing remaining snow.

SOUTH VALLEY FBO TO CLOSE FOR THE HOLIDAYS

The South Valley Regional Airport FBO will be closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Self-service 100LL and Jet A will be available for those who need fuel. General Aviation runways at TVY and U42 will close when RCAM readings are O or 1. Check NOTAMS.
