Fall Airport Hanger Inspections Coming in October

Fall hangar inspections will occur on October 5 at South Valley Regional Airport and October 6 at Salt Lake City International. Inspectors will check the hangar to ensure lease compliance.

Key inspection points include the following:

- Fire Extinguishers must have a current valid inspection sticker
- Hazardous materials must be stored properly
- Electrical cords must be sized properly
- Aircraft stored in the hangar should comply with lease
