Taxiway K Overlay Project Starts on July 15

The Taxiway K Overlay project is scheduled to begin on July 15. The project will take place in six separate phases and is expected to take 90 days to complete. Aircraft will experience taxi route changes during the different phases of the project. Aircraft operators need to continually check NOTAMS during the project and plan accordingly. Extra time should be given to allow for additional taxi distances and routes.

The Salt Lake City Department of Airports will hold a tenant briefing concerning the project on Monday, July 8 at 11 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Airport Training and Activities Center, 1911 North 2200 West.

TVY South Ramp Open

The contractor finished the Tooele overlay project on June 24. The project included a complete pavement overlay, new tie-down anchors, new markings and a new helipad design. The current paint markings are temporary and will be repainted in 30 days.

Ramp Work at South Valley Coming Soon

The FAA recently awarded the Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) \$900,000 in funding to work on ramp areas at the airport. The project is primarily focused on the pavement around the north hangar complex to include hangar rows A-D. The project is still early in the planning phase, however, work is estimated to start by end of August. More information will be available once plans are finalized.

TVY Construction Closures

Ramp construction at the Tooele Valley Airport began Monday, April 29 and will continue for 19 days. Closed areas include taxiway A3, taxiway A between the north and the south ramp and the south parking apron. Aircraft north of the closure are required to back taxi on the runway for a runway 35 departure. Please check NOTAMS and plan accordingly.

St. George Airport Construction Closures

Runway 1/19 at St. George Municipal Airport (SGU) is undergoing major reconstruction this summer. The runway is closed between May 29 and Sept. 26. The airport will be closed to all fixed wing aircraft during this time.
