The New SLC Updates

The New SLC Airport Redevelopment Program's first phase is moving full steam ahead and is scheduled to open to the public Sept. 15. Inside the Terminal, the luggage conveyor belt has been commissioned, security screening equipment is in place and baggage carousels installed. In addition, the large-scale art installations--The Canyons and The Falls--are well underway.



In light of fewer passenger traffic, the SLC team has been exploring options to determine the best way to move forward with Phase II of The New SLC. After many meetings, phone calls with airlines, reconfiguration of gates and number crunching, the airport decided to proceed with demolition of all existing facilities after October 2020. Instead of keeping Concourse F and Concourse C open during the second phase of construction as was initially planned, they will be torn down. The parking garage, terminals and concourses G and D were already slated for demolition early on. The condensed timeline-completion by December 2024, rather than early 2027-will shorten Phase II by two years and is expected to save up to \$300 million. Phase II includes building out the east side of Concourse A.

Increased Night Helicopter Traffic at South Valley in July

South Valley Regional Airport will experience increased night helicopter traffic between July 3 and 23. An Army National Guard unit is visiting and will conduct flights with CH-47 Chinook helicopters. All pilots are encouraged to use extra caution during this time.

TVY Fuel System Out of Service Until Further Notice

The self-serve 100LL fuel pump at Tooele Valley Airport remains out of service. There is no estimated date for the service to return.

Skydiving Resumes at TVY

Skydive Utah resumed operations at Tooele Valley Airport in late June. Airport users can expect to see skydiving operations at the airport Wednesday through Sunday between sunrise and sunset. Use caution when operating at TVA during this time to insure the skydivers have a safe experience.
