Bright served as a Women's Airforce Service Pilot (WASP) during World War II. The WASP program trained female pilots to test and ferry aircraft as well as to train other pilots. Only 1,074 female pilots, out of 25,000 who applied, earned their wings from the program. Bright is one of 25 surviving WASP pilots.
