Tooele Valley Airport Runway Closes May 23 and 24

As a part of spring maintenance, Tooele Valley Airport's airfield will be closed from 7 a.m. on May 23 until 9 p.m. on May 24. The closure will allow for taxiway and runway painting. The instrument landing system will also be unavailable during that time. Pilots are asked to avoid flying low over the runway during the closure as a courtesy for crews working on the ground.

Sky Lantern Festival Near Tooele Valley Airport May 19 and 20
