- -Check out a new art installation—Swallows in Flight—in Concourse B-west.
- -Explore the two new lounges in Concourse B—AmEx Centurion Club and Delta Sky Club. Six more shops and restaurants are now open on Concourse B-east as well.
- -Access one of three Sensory Rooms designed for individuals who may need a break in a quieter environment.
- -Enjoy the holiday performers scheduled at the airport on Wednesday with everything from jazz music to guitar players to create a calming travel environment.
- -Remain in the Park and Wait lot for arriving guests until passengers have picked up their bags and are curbside.
