DEMOLITION OF PARKING EXIT RAMP PLANNED

- What:** The exit ramp to what was previously the drive-through lane of the Airport's short-term parking garage will be demolished. The drive-through lane was closed in October and converted to Premium Parking. The exit ramp area—as well as what formerly housed car rental canopies—will become a new roadway exiting the airport the summer of 2016 to prepare for future construction projects.
- When:** Tuesday, Feb. 23, 2016. Demolition begins in the morning. The best time for photos will be at approximately 10:00 a.m.
- Where:** Meet on the second level of short-term parking on the west end at 10:00 a.m. Parking is available in the parking garage for a fee or in the media parking area at the south end of Terminal 1 by the Trax station.
- Why:** The airport is undergoing a \$1.8 billion redevelopment program, the first phase of which will be completed in 2020. The public will soon start to see more construction at the Salt Lake International Airport as part of the Terminal Redevelopment Program (TRP).
