For those wishing to establish themselves as a Ground Transportation Business to provide transportation services in Salt Lake City and/or at the Airport must complete all the following items:	
State Registration	Your company name must first be registered with the Utah State Department of Commerce. Their office is located at: 160 E Broadway, Salt Lake City UT 84111.
Business License	Secure a Salt Lake City Business License as required by Salt Lake City Code 5.71.050. Their office is in the Salt Lake City/County Building 451 South State St. Salt Lake City, UT 84114.
Read City Ordinances	Read and become familiar with all Ground Transportation Ordinances as contained in Salt Lake City Codes 5.71, 16.60 & 16.64 as well as the Salt Lake City Airport Ground Transportation Rules and Regulations. Links to these can be found on our website: slcairport.com/ground-transportation
Apply for Airport Badge	Visit https://slcairport.com/ground-transportation/get-a-badge/ and follow instructions on how to obtain an Airport Operators Badge. This process can take up to 2-weeks. The Badging Office is location can be found here: https://slcairport.com/ground-transportation/maps/.
Register with Ground Transportation Office	To register your company with the Ground Transportation Office, and have your vehicles inspected for operation, the following will be required: A completed Ground Transportation Registration Form (enclosed) A copy of your Salt Lake City Business License Proof of a current Utah State Safety Inspection for each vehicle Certificate of Insurance (ACORD Form) (see enclosed Insurance Checklist). *Please note that insurance documents must be sent to our office by your insurance agent. We cannot accept those documents from you.
