

Good morning,

After a recent review of insurance requirements for ground transportation, it has been determined that coverage levels have increased from \$1,000,000 to \$1,500,000 for vehicles that have (15) seats or less. Per 5.71.140 every ground transportation vehicle shall be covered by automobile liability insurance, when the vehicle is available for or being used for the transportation of persons using Salt Lake City streets for commercial purposes, at the minimum levels of coverage set forth by the federal motor carrier safety administration, 49 CFR 387.33, or by the Utah department of transportation, or by the United States department of transportation, whichever levels are higher. For your reference, here are the links to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Admin (FMCSA), and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT).
