Subject: New Drop Off Area - Parking Structure

All,

Effective today, we are opening a new area that you may use as a “Drop and Go Zone” when using the parking structure. This area will accommodate (4) four vehicles and is intended for quick turnaround operations. If you are performing a meet and greet service, please continue to park in any open stall in the parking structure and enter the facility. As you already know, there are no time restrictions as you are paying to park. This new area was created to eliminate vehicles blocking thru traffic when dropping off customers and is located on the west side of the parking structure adjacent to the moving walkway.

As seen in Image 1, this area is not to be used for dropping off customers and shall only be used as a drive lane. Operators witnessed using this area for operations will be issued a citation. Please use the newly designated area near the moving walkway, and please follow the signage as seen in Images 2-4. If vehicles are witnessed parking in this area for longer than the designated 5 minutes, or leaving their vehicles unattended, operators will be cited.

The last photo (Image 5) shows the overhead view and the simplicity of the design. Please follow the ground markings when operating in the area. To access, enter from the south, and exit at the north end. If this area is successful and we find that it eliminates congestion, we will review creating a similar zone on the east end of the parking structure.

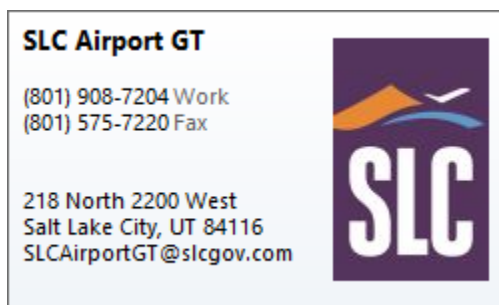


Image 1: Please do not operate here.
